In these exercises you will learn about note values and how they work.

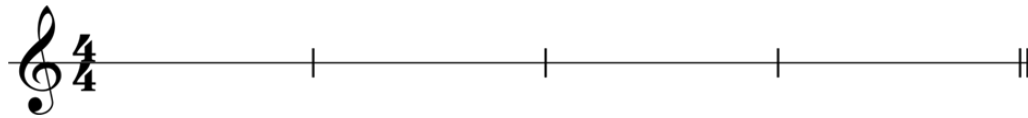
1 This is a semibreve.



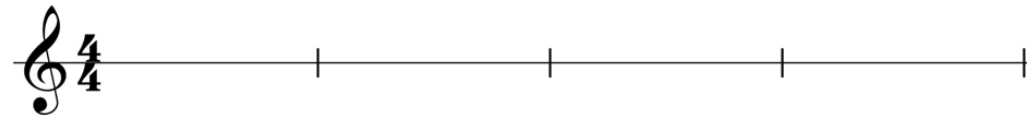
2 It has a value that lasts the same as four single crotchet beats.



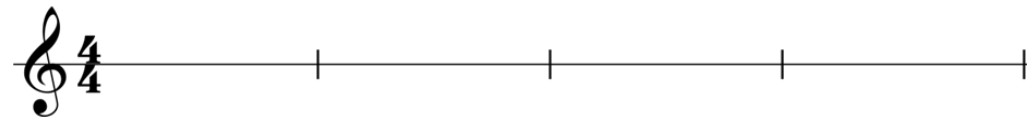

2. On the line below, write four **crotchets** in each bar:



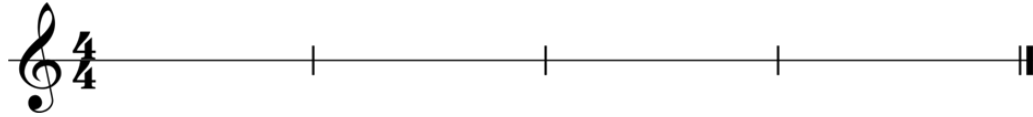

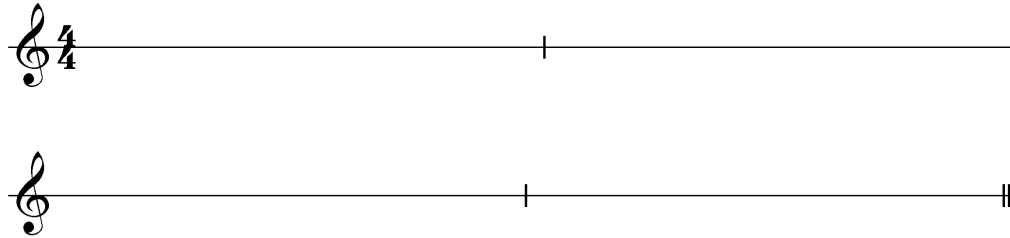

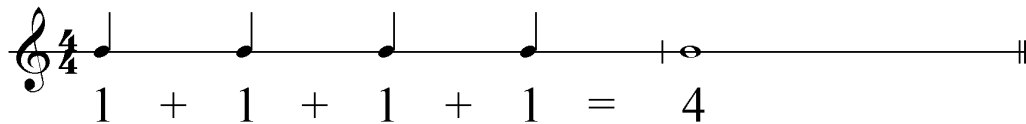
